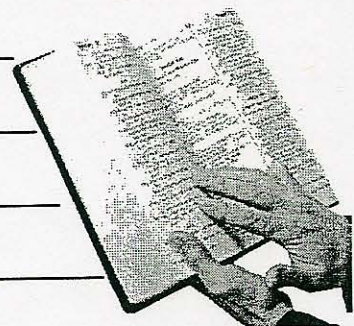

FICTION: POSTER

- * Pay attention to capitalization and good sentence structure.

Number of Pages

Other Information that should be included:

What difficulty arises and how is it resolved?

Is there a moral or lesson to be learned from this story?

Would you recommend this book?

Ways to present your oral report:

Be imaginative! You might want to write a song or a poem about the book or character in the book. You may feel more comfortable just "talking about your book." Your oral report should take about two minutes.

You may use not cards to remind yourself of the things you want to talk about.
